The TransCon has over 4,647 route miles traversing 13 states

Over 66 million people live and work in the areas served by the TransCon

Areas served by the TransCon account for \$3.9 trillion in gross domestic product and over 28 million jobs



The TransCon Corridor hauls the consumer goods that we all use everyday. From T-shirts and TVs to corn and wheat, this major route serves as an import/export gateway for our nation's consumers and businesses.

In 2009, the TransCon moved over 235 million tons of freight valued at \$162 billion. To move the same amount of freight by road would require over 9.4 million trucks. The TransCon saved over 1 billion gallons of fuel and 11 million tons of greenhouse gases.

BNSF and its partners invested more than \$1.8 billion in the TransCon over the past decade to create even greater efficiency. Some of the biggest projects completed in recent years include:

- Double and Triple Tracking - BNSF spent over \$800 million in the last 10 years to double and triple track the TransCon
- Memphis Intermodal Facility - The recent completion of a \$200 million expansion and rebuilding of the Memphis Intermodal Facility will double BNSF's lift capacity in the Memphis market
- Cajon Pass - Completed in 2008, this \$100M project extended a third main track from the Los Angeles basin up through Cajon Pass
- Maintenance - Almost \$3.3 billion was spent on the TransCon in the last 10 years to ensure maximum safety and efficiency

BNSF is continuously investing in the TransCon Corridor. There are projects planned or underway on the Corridor throughout the nation. Improvements to and expansions of the TransCon's rail infrastructure will create jobs, enable economic growth, and keep trucks off of the road to conserve fuel, reduce greenhouse gas emissions, and make communities and roadways safer.
